3. Tournament Director (Coach Anne Woolweaver)
 - a. Tournament Entry Fees
 - b. Admission for event, Programs for event
 - c. Where to park
 - d. Location of locker rooms – no deck changing!
 - e. No beverages, glass or pets allowed on pool deck.
 - f. Noise Makers and folding chairs are NOT allowed in stands or on the pool deck
 - g. Warm up area, Warm up Procedures
 - h. Location of Benches and Tables
 - i. Seating for fans, athletes and coaches not playing in bleachers (only pregame immediately before, playing game, and post game-immediately after game athletes in stands on deck)
 - j. Security for Event, Tournament Expectations for Parents, Coaches, and Athletes
 - k. Hospitality Area for Coaches and Game Officials ONLY. Ref Area off limits to coaches/athletes.
